



THEOBEN BARREL PULL THROUGH

For the safest way to clean your air rifle barrel without fear of damage to rifling or action.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

On 12ft/lbs Rapid type rifles remove silencer by unscrewing grub screw. All other Theoben rifles the silencer is permanently fixed - see tip below.

1. Break barrel or pull back the bolt.
2. Push loop end down through muzzle* (though silencer if still in place) until it exits at the breech (magazine slot on Rapid rifles).
3. Slip a 10cm (4") length of the Napier cloth provided in the kit through the loop and pull back through the barrel.
4. Draw pull-through from the breech to muzzle, using steady pressure, until Napier cloth emerges.
5. Repeat until Napier cloth comes out clean.

Tip:



* For rifles with the silencer or barrel weight permanently fixed. A drinking straw can be used to guide the loop through the silencer or barrel weight.

NOTE

A reduction in accuracy for the first 5 to 10 shots after cleaning may be experienced but will soon settle back down when a small amount of re-leading has taken place. For absolute accuracy with FAC Air Rifles it is recommended that barrel cleaning should take place every 100 to 200 shots.

This kit contains; 28 inch (700mm) pull through, 6 Napier Cloth patches

A Replacement Napier Cloth dispenser pack can be bought from Theoben it contains 580 inches (14m) of Napier Cloth.

Designed for effective cleaning of all rifled bores. Will remove excess solvents and all fouling in one action. Strong and safe, will not lint, fray, tear or scratch. Unaffected by solvents and oils.

THEOBEN ONLY RECOMMEND THE USE OF NAPIER CLOTH
